There are updates to CA Volume II 2013 published to http://www.ccrca.org/Cancer_Reporting/Registrar_Resources/Reporting_Cancer_Cal.shtml under the Volume II header. Changes are found in the Summary of Changes section of the document, and are also listed here for your convenience:

- The field Mult Tumors Reported as on Primary (CCR Identifier E1076) is now optional.
- The field Multiplicity Counter (CCR Identifier E1079) is now optional.
- The field Date of Multiple Tumors (CCR Identifier E1077) is now optional.
- The field Date of Multiple Tumors Flag (CCR Identifier E1078) is now optional.
- The field Date of Conclusive DX (CCR Identifier E1074) is now optional.
- The field Date of Conclusive DX Flag (CCR Identifier E1075) is now optional.
- The field Ambiguous Terminology (CCR Identifier E1073) is now optional.
- For NAACCR v13 the CER data items, located in positions 5133 - 5564, should no longer be transmitted to the central registry, nor should corrections be sent for those data items either.
